#### PRE-NUPTIAL INVESTIGATION: Form M-B

The priest, deacon or auditor should interview the witness in person. However, if this is not possible, the interview may be conducted by telephone. The introductory questions should be asked in addition to the questions from the applicable section or sections. The witness should then sign and date the affidavit. If the interview is conducted by telephone, the minister should write "telephone interview" on the line for the witness signature.

### 1. TO ESTABLISH BAPTISM OR NON-BAPTISM

This section must be completed (1) to prove that the bride was baptized when no baptismal certificate is available or (2) to establish that the bride was never baptized. Affidavits from both parents are preferred. If not possible, then from one parent and one close relative, or two close relatives.

## 2. REGARDING FREEDOM TO MARRY

This section must be completed when (1) the bride is not a Catholic; or (2) the only baptismal certificate available for the Catholic bride is older than six months; or (3) the current baptismal certificate of the Catholic bride has no sacramental notations; or (4) the Catholic bride is personally unknown to the priest or deacon; or (5) this form is being used as part of a Lack of Canonical Form petition, N.B. the witness is testifying to the petitioner's current status. Affidavits from two close relatives or life-long friends are usually required.
