

The Right of Parents/Legal Guardians to Refuse Safe Environment Training for Children and Youth

According to Bishop's Charter and our diocesan policy, parents/legal guardians are to be informed that they have the right to refuse to allow their child(ren) to attend Safe Environment training held at a parish or Catholic school. It is NOT required to get parent/legal guardian permission for their child/children to attend Safe Environment training.

The Youth Absence from Safe Environment Training Option Form is **NOT** a permission slip, nor does it inform parents/legal guardians that they can refuse the training. This form is sent AFTER the child misses the training due to absence or refusal, along with the Home Training Packet.

Please see the statement below which you may use to easily inform parents/legal guardians of their right to refuse the training for their child(ren). If parents/legal guardians notify you in writing(preferred) or phone call, then withhold the child(ren) from the presentation.

Catholic Schools:

Include the following information in your letter/notification concerning Safe Environment Training. The information can be rearranged as necessary to fit your specific letter/notification

Our school is mandated by the Bishops of the United States to provide Safe Environment training to a students annually. Your child/children will receive this training sometime during this school year, quarte month.
