

Parish Place Training – Social Media: Facebook

1. Open your Facebook page using any browser and highlight the web address.
2. **Right click** on the highlighted web address and choose **copy**.
3. Log into the **Parish Place** interface.
4. Click the **Social Media Feed** link under the **Manage Content** heading.
5. Click once in the Social Media box at the top of the screen.
6. Press **Ctrl + A** to select the code.
7. Click the **delete** key on your keyboard to clear the box.
8. Under the **Facebook** heading, click the blue link next to the words **“Fill out this form.”** The **Facebook plugin** page appears.
9. Paste the web address for your Facebook page in the Facebook Page URL field.
10. Scroll down to the bottom of the screen and click the **Get Code** button. The **Javascript SDK iframe** window will open.
11. Click once in the **Step 1** box. The code will highlight in blue.
12. **Right click** on the highlighted code and press **Copy**
13. Switch back to the Parish Place interface.
14. **Right click** in the Social Media box and choose **Paste**.
15. Press the **Enter** key on your keyboard once.
16. Switch back to the **Javascript SDK iframe** window.
17. Click once in the **Step 2** box to highlight the code.
18. **Right click** on the highlighted code and press **Copy**
19. Switch to the **Parish Place** interface.
20. **Right click** at the bottom of the code you pasted in the Social Media box and choose **Paste**.
21. Click Publish.
22. Check your live page, your Facebook Feed should appear.

Step 1: Include the JavaScript SDK on your page once, ideally right after the opening body tag.

  fjs.parentNode.insertBefore(js, fjs);
})(document, 'script', 'facebook-jssdk');</script>

Step 2: Place this code wherever you want the plugin to appear on your page.
