

DECREE

Clarifying the boundaries of Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish, Mercer

Whereas the Diocese of Erie has been engaged in ongoing pastoral planning for over a decade; and whereas this pastoral planning has resulted in numerous parish and deanery reconfigurations; and whereas I am taking this opportunity to ensure that the geographic territory of the Diocese of Erie is entirely distributed into territorial parishes without gap or overlap;

Therefore, I hereby define the boundaries of Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish in Mercer as follows:

In Mercer County, beginning where Interstate 79 crosses the Mercer/Lawrence County line; west on the Mercer/Lawrence County line to Little Neshannock Creek in Wilmington Township; north along Little Neshannock Creek to Jefferson Township; west on the Jefferson/Lackawannock township line to Hermitage; north on the western border of Jefferson Township and continuing north on the Delaware township border to state road 3022; southeast on state road 3022 to the Delaware/Jefferson township line; east on the Jefferson/Delaware township line and continuing east on the Coolspring/Fairview township line to their eastern border; south on the Coolspring/Jackson township line to Findley township; east on the Findley/Jackson township line to Interstate 79; south on Interstate 79 to the Mercer/Lawrence County line.

This decree is effective the First Sunday of Advent, December 1, 2024. Anything to the contrary notwithstanding.
