

## **DECREE**

Clarifying the boundaries of Saint Francis of Assisi Parish, Clearfield

Whereas the Diocese of Erie has been engaged in ongoing pastoral planning for over a decade; and whereas this pastoral planning has resulted in numerous parish and deanery reconfigurations; and whereas I am taking this opportunity to ensure that the geographic territory of the Diocese of Erie is entirely distributed into territorial parishes without gap or overlap;

Therefore, I hereby define the boundaries of Saint Francis of Assisi Parish in Clearfield as follows:

In Clearfield County, beginning at the northwest corner of Lawrence Township on the Clearfield/Elk County line; east on the Clearfield/Elk County line to the Goshen/Girard township line; south on the Goshen/Girard township line to the Susquehanna River; west on the Susquehanna River to PA Route 970; south on PA Route 970 to US Route 322; south west on US Route 322 to state road 2007 at West Decatur; south on state road 2007 to state road 2024; northwest on state road 2024 to Pike Township; north on the Lawrence/Pike township line to Pine Township; west on the Pine/Pike township line; north on the Pine/Union township line to Huston Township; east on the Pine/Huston township line to Lawrence Township; north on the Lawrence/Huston township line to the northwest corner of Lawrence Township on the Clearfield/Elk County line.

This decree is effective the First Sunday of Advent, December 1, 2024. Anything to the contrary notwithstanding.
