

## **DECREE**

Clarifying the boundaries of Saint Joseph Parish, Oil City

Whereas the Diocese of Erie has been engaged in ongoing pastoral planning for over a decade; and whereas this pastoral planning has resulted in numerous parish and deanery reconfigurations; and whereas I am taking this opportunity to ensure that the geographic territory of the Diocese of Erie is entirely distributed into territorial parishes without gap or overlap;

Therefore, I hereby define the boundaries of Saint Joseph Parish in Oil City as follows:

In Venango County, beginning at the Venango/Forest County border at the Allegheny/President township line; south on the Venango/Forest County border to Little East Sandy Creek; west on East Sandy Creek to the Allegheny River; then a straight line north to the eastern edge of Two Mile Run Reservoir at the northern boundary of Sugarcreek Borough (an imaginary line halfway between Franklin and Oil City); west on the Sugarcreek/Oakland Township line to Jackson Township, north on the Oakland/Jackson Township line to Plum Township; east on the northern borders of Oakland, Cornplanter, and President Townships to the Venango/Forest County border.

This decree is effective the First Sunday of Advent, December 1, 2024. Anything to the contrary notwithstanding.
