

## DECREE

Clarifying the boundaries of Saint Michael Parish, Fryburg

Whereas the Diocese of Erie has been engaged in ongoing pastoral planning for over a decade; and whereas this pastoral planning has resulted in numerous parish and deanery reconfigurations; and whereas I am taking this opportunity to ensure that the geographic territory of the Diocese of Erie is entirely distributed into territorial parishes without gap or overlap;

Therefore, I hereby define the boundaries of Saint Michael Parish in Fryburg as follows:

In Clarion County, beginning where PA Route 36 intersects the Clarion/Forest County line; south on PA Route 36 to the Washington/Farmington township line; south and then west on the Washington township boundary to PA Route 208; south on PA Route 208 to Millerstown Road at Millerstown; west on Millerstown Road to the Ashland Township line; north on the Elk/Ashland township line to the Clarion/Venango County line; northeast on the Venango County line to PA Route 36.

This decree is effective the First Sunday of Advent, December 1, 2024. Anything to the contrary notwithstanding.
