

Structure of the Litany of Saints

- I. Kyrie Eleison
 - II. The Blessed Mother
 - III. Angels
 - IV. Saints
 - a. Patriarchs and Prophets (Saint Joseph is always last)
 - b. Apostles and the Disciples of the Lord
 - c. Martyrs
 - d. Bishops and Doctors of the Church
 - e. Priests and Religious
 - f. Laity (Customarily, male saints are listed before female saints.)
 - V. Invocations addressed to Christ
 - VI. Invocation of Christ's mysteries
 - VII. Supplications for various necessities
- Only the names of Saints and Blessed listed in the Church's Martyrologies may be used Liturgically.
 - The saint names should appear in their proper categories and in historical order by date of death.
 - A member of a religious order is placed after his/her founder
 - The invocation of the Saints may be personalized for funeral rites and for the Commemoration of All Souls (E.g. "Pray for him/her" or "Pray for them")
