APRIL:

ATTEND a Mother-Daughter Tea which is designed for girls age 10 and older and their moms. This program explores God's special gift of human fertility and the beauty and wonder of growing up and becoming a woman.

DISCUSS vocations and the states of life: single, clergy & religious, and married.

PRAY for your child and encourage your child to pray to hear God's calling.

MAY:

FOSTER a devotion to the Immaculate Mother of God. It is very difficult to stay totally pure through one's own will power. Pray to our Blessed Mother for purity of heart!

OCTOBER:

ADOPT a routine of daily prayer for your child and your child's future spouse.

READ to understand your vital role in your child's sexuality and chastity education. Your role as primary educator can not be usurped. *Familiaris Consortio*, 36

BEGIN with *Sexuality 101 Parents' Manual* as a primer.

NOVEMBER:

READ the *Theology of the Body for Middle Schoolers* parent guide to gain an understanding of what your child will learn and to be prepared for conversations regarding sexuality.

DEVISE a *PLAN OF ACTION* for your family including your guidelines for proper dress, curfews, media consumption, dating, etc. Don't be afraid to set high standards!

ATTEND a Family Honor Program in your area.

DECEMBER:

RESEARCH and discover the wonderful helps available to you! Google "chastity" and be prudent to read those hits that are Catholic and/or Christian in nature.

INTRODUCE your child to Pure Love Club and start a club in your locality (or encourage someone else to lead with your help!) See resources on page 4.

CONTINUE to work on your *PLAN OF ACTION* for your family. Think of the location of your home's computers: Does your child have unlimited access with no accountability? This could be a grave temptation for sin. Consider having all computers in communal living space to reduce the possibility of risky internet behavior.

JANUARY:

HOST a New Year's Eve party for your family to introduce and celebrate your *PLAN OF ACTION*. Discuss your newfound knowledge and information regarding chastity and ways your family will strive to live it.

Remember: Laws (rules, guidelines, etc.) are for protection, not restriction! This is the key to understanding and appreciating God's laws. Remind your family that the family plan is for personal fortification!

After you have adequately discussed chastity with your child and outlined your family plan, present your child with a chastity ring as a symbol of his/her pledge of purity.

FEBRUARY:

LISTEN to the music your child listens to. Are the overall messages of the songs moral, immoral, or amoral? Do they conflict with the Christian message? If yes, discuss with your child and together find reasonable substitutes by looking for Christian music in all genres (or at least morally acceptable music!)

TEACH your child to be vigilant in avoiding pornography. Discuss its negative effects.

Filter your internet access and prohibit the viewing of indecent television shows and movies. *Familiaris Consortio*, 76

MARCH:

STUDY the virtues and their opposing vices/sins. On Sunday morning, write a note explaining the "virtue/vice of the week" and discuss examples of both.
